Certifications: Upon successful completion of the program, you will be eligible to take the certification exam from the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT). Successful completion of the exam is required in order to be certified as an EMT in Connecticut.

Please note: Course fees do not include a blood pressure cuff, a stethoscope, national exam fees, or textbooks. Textbooks will be available for purchase through Hartford HealthCare and must be obtained before the first day of class.
